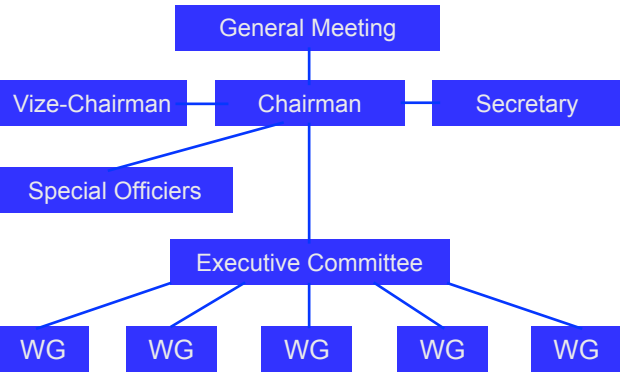

EUSAS e.V. is the European Society for Automatic Alarm Systems e.V. It provides a European platform for promoting fire protection and security comprising fire detection, extinguishing, intrusion detection, access control and video monitoring.

What led to the foundation of EUSAS?

In most areas of science and technology scientists and engineers benefit from platforms such as scientific conferences and workshops to exchange ideas and discuss latest scientific and technological advances. These information exchanges, notably also between academic and industry representatives, are an established and important component in networking the scientific and engineering community. It is well recognized that such information exchanges have a positive impact on the development of new and innovative technologies and products as well as the growth of the markets of interest. In turn the customer benefits from better products and services.

In the field of electronic life safety and security systems the AUBE conferences offer such a platform. This conference developed from a discussion workshop on automatic fire detection (Automatische Brandentdeckung) to a conference on electronic fire and security systems of international recognition. The AUBE conference only takes place on average every three years, i.e. a time sequence rather long compared to the innovation cycles of today. This conference also tends to become quite a big and formal event with tight time schedules that make informal and in depth discussions rather difficult.

In recognition of these circumstances the European Society for Automatic Alarm Systems (EUSAS), with headquarters in Germany, was founded on December 11, 1989, to offer the stakeholders of the electronic fire and security systems industry a platform for a more frequent exchange and discussion on relevant topics in a conducive environment. In 2007, EUSAS e.V. was founded and took over the operational business of EUSAS (including its members) from January 1, 2008.

EUSAS e.V. is a non-profit organisation.

• Reduction of EUSAS e.V. workshop fees to 50%

EUSAS conference fees are typically about 300 to 400 € for a two day conference, so your benefit results to at least 150 € per EUSAS conference.

EUSAS performs 1-2 conferences each year with the most interesting topics in the scene. So please figure out your benefit. As one element of benefits, these discounts should motivate you to become a member of EUSAS, with a membership of at least two years.

So please understand that the conference fee reduction of 50 % is only valid for those persons which are EUSAS members for more than 12 months. Other, younger EUSAS members will receive a conference fee reduction of 25 %.

• Contacts with the top experts in the field

Get to know and keep in contact with junior and senior European experts in the fire detection and security area you always wanted to see. Many European experts in this area are members of EUSAS. At the EUSAS General Meeting, social events and especially at EUSAS conferences you will get to know them, keep in contact with them and obtain valuable information. That alone could be worth many times the EUSAS fee.

• Admission to the EUSAS e.V. database

In the EUSAS database, accessible by a restricted area in the EUSAS website, you are able to download and perform detailed investigations. The key to the database is emailed to you after reception of the EUSAS membership fee.

The EUSAS database includes all EUSAS publications, from the most recent ones to those issued just after the foundation of EUSAS in 1989. The EUSAS database will continuously be extended concerning other important proceedings (like the AUBE conference), links to other important fire and security websites and much more. There is a free download of all EUSAS Newsletters and Journals, so you don't need to store EUSAS publications in your bookshelf.

• EUSAS e.V. keeps you informed

The EUSAS Newsletter informs you after each conference about the abstracts and about other upcoming conferences and workshops. Full papers of conference presentations can be found in the EUSAS Journal. EUSAS members benefit from free paper copies of the EUSAS Journal or from the CD versions.
