Fire Protection and Security in Historical Buildings and Museums

Aim of the conference

Art objects and cultural assets shown in museums are endangered by several threats like fire and vandalism and thus have to be protected in a comprehensive way. Also for historical buildings a similar situation exists.

Aim of the conference is to give an overview about general and specialized fire protection prescriptions for heritage buildings and museums in different EU countries. Both passive and active fire protection solutions for such objects are presented. Security aspects are also discussed. In addition to user experiences important examples of corresponding protection concepts are shown.

Target group

The conference is targeted at representatives of the electronic fire protection industry, insurers, authorities (like fire brigades), test houses, safety and security personnel and customers with high and/or special risk potential, whose demands and inputs are highly welcome at the discussion.
